

BYLAW NO. 1/11

A Bylaw respecting the location of open gravel pits in the Municipality.

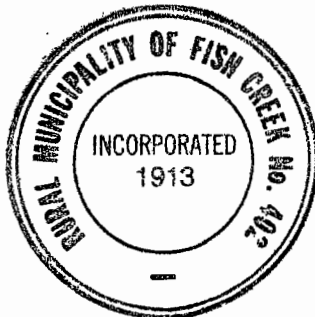
The Council of the Rural Municipality of Fish Creek No. 402, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. In this Bylaw: "road" means any road allowance within the Rural Municipality of Fish Creek No. 402 other than a private road and a Provincial highway.
2. No open gravel pits or stock piles of gravel shall be situated a distance less than:

**150 feet from the center of any road and
300 feet from the center of any intersection**
3. This bylaw does not apply to any gravel pits situated prior to the passing of this Bylaw.
4. Every person who is found to be in contravention of this bylaw shall be guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties imposed in the General Penalty Bylaw of the RM of Fish Creek No. 402


