

BYLAW 2024-06

A BYLAW TO FIX RATES TO BE CHARGED FOR THE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF WASTES OR REFUSE, AND TO PROVIDE FOR TRANSFERRING OF ANY UNPAID ACCOUNTS TO THE TAX ROLL

The Council of Fish Creek No. 402 in the Province of Saskatchewan repeals bylaw 2024-01 enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw, including this section:
 - a) "municipality" means the RM of Fish Creek #402;
 - b) "administrator" means the administrator or acting clerk of the municipality.
2. Persons who own a premise being served with the collection, removal, or disposal of solid wastes or other refuse shall pay for such services a charge as set out below:
 - a) Residential 3 Yard Bin - \$28.67 per tip which includes (1) one waste cart that is dumped on a (4) four weeks schedule.
 - i) Residents shall have the ability to cancel their tip by contacting Greenland Waste. In choosing not to participate in a regular schedule there is will a \$15.00 rental fee for missed tips.
 - b) Residents with new and exciting services will be invoiced by the municipality.
 - b) Billing for collection, removal or disposal of solid waste or other refuse, shall be invoiced through the Municipality every (4) four weeks and shall be payable within (30) thirty days of the date of the invoice.
3. Accounts for collection, removal or disposal of solid waste or other refuse that are unpaid after the end of the current billing period shall be considered in arrears and the service may be discontinued. In the event the service is discontinued, it will not be reinstated until the account is brought to current and arrears have been paid in full.
4. Any sum payable to the Municipality for the collection, removal or disposal of solid wastes and other refuse that remains unpaid on December 31 of the year in which the sum became payable may be added to, and thereby form part of the taxes on the land and/or buildings in respect of which the collection, removal or disposal was done and a penalty of 10% will be added at yearend.
5. The homeowners three-yard bin delivery fee of \$45.00 will be covered by the RM of Fish Creek No. 402. If a bin becomes damaged due to lost, damaged, stolen or due to an act of nature the account associated with said bin shall be charged \$150.00 for a replacement bin, \$50.00 for a replacement lid, if the bin is fully burnt and/or in need of sand blasting the homeowner to be billed \$500.00. Bins are the responsibility of the homeowners once delivered to their property. If Greenland Waste damages the cart during tipping, they will replace the bin at no charge.
6. An occupier of a residential property garbage collection service must store all garbage containers on the property to which they belong, and ensure that they do not encroach from such property, or project over any street, lane or other public place.
7. An occupier of a residential property garbage collection service who does not abide to Section 7 shall be subject to the following fines and may have their service cancelled.
 - (a) First offence - \$20.00
 - (b) Second offence - \$50.00
 - (c) Third offence - Cancellation of service
